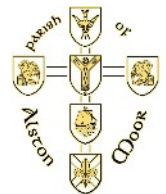

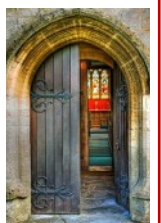
All our parish churches are now open:
